The presenting author does not have to be the first author. Abstracts must be written in English and must not exceed 300 words. The abstract must clearly present the purpose, the work, and the results reported in the future paper in order to allow for evaluation of its scientific content. Do not include graphs and photos in the abstract. Abstract should be typed in 12-point Times New Roman, justified with one and a half line spacing, vertical, on A4 sized paper format with 2.5 cm margins.
